



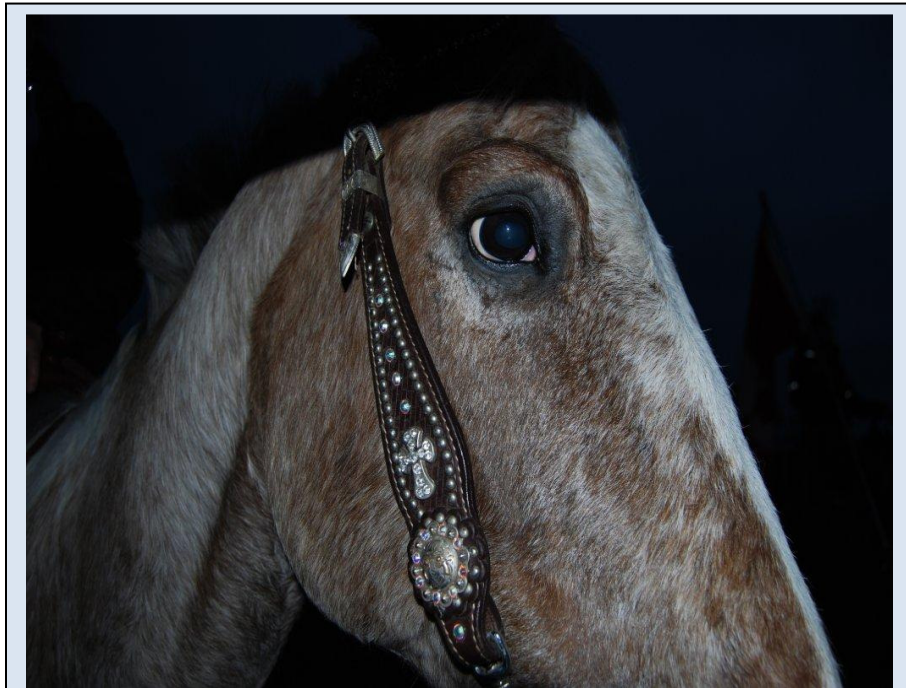

**Directions Info:**

The Horse Park site is located just east of the Cascade Range off Interstate 90 in Cle Elum and it is easy to reach from all over the state - only 1½ hours from Seattle and under 4 hours from Spokane.

**From I90 Eastbound** -Take Exit 84; after exit ramp take first left (between Chevron and Windermere) onto Douglas Munro Blvd., stay on this road as it quickly turns left and proceed 0.7 miles past cemetery to entrance to the Horse Park.

**From I90 Westbound** -Take Exit 84; at end of exit ramp turn right onto Oakes Ave., proceed 0.5 miles to light; make left onto W. First St. and continue 0.7 miles; make right (between Chevron and Windermere) onto Douglas Munro Blvd., stay on this road as it quickly turns left and proceed 0.7 miles past cemetery to entrance to the Horse Park.

**Proper equestrian gear required for both horse and rider. Please read the rules on proper gear for your horse.**

**PANEL RENTALS**

Langley Riders now have portable panels for rent. These panels are ideal for when you are at a rodeo or horse show and there is no stabling available. Just build your own pen on the side of your trailer and your horses are with you at all times. One "panel" is a tri-fold, and 2 panels are usually required to make a pen large enough for your horse. The panels are made of tubing, similar to the panels in the main arena.

Rental fees: Rent is \$10.00 per day, for 2 panels. **In other words, if you pick up 2 panels on Friday and bring them back Monday,** you will pay 30.00. We use the same principal as the rental companies, we charge for TIME OUT not TIME USED. At the present time, we will rent to club members only, so no deposit will be required.
